The Terai region is home to the Chitwan and Bardia national parks. These wildlife parks were established to protect these endangered animals and the environment they live in. They are the premier places in Asia to enjoy a true jungle experience. Our packages include everything from jungle activities to accommodations to transportation to and from the parks.

Bardia National Park

Bardia National Park is smaller than Chitwan but is home to the same exotic animal life and jungle environment of the Terai. Bardia is more isolated than Chitwan which is why it has fewer resorts and fewer visitors. But this also adds to the excitement of exploring this jungle. All resorts border the boundary of the park. The resorts are all lovely and offer Bardia National Park as their front yard.



There are a wide variety of jungle activities available in both parks.

Elephant rides are the best way to explore the jungle and search for wildlife. Jeep safaris are also available for those who don't feel like riding an elephant. Others might enjoy a jungle walk with an experienced guide who can tell you all about the wildlife and vegetation that is unique to the Terai region. Canoeing on the Rapti or Narayani rivers is a great way to see the many different bird species, and there's always the rare chance that you can see the elusive freshwater Ganges River Dolphin that inhabit the rivers. All of these activities are included in your jungle package.

Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve

Established in 1976, Koshi Tappu Wildlife Reserve is 175 square kilometres of wildlife refuge and wetlands habitat. It is located in Eastern Nepal and can be accessed from the Mahindra Highway. It comprises extensive mudflats, reed beds, and freshwater marshes in the

floodplain of the Sapta Kosi River, and ranges in altitude



from 75 to 81 m (246 to 266 ft.). It was established in 1976 and designated as a Ramsar site in December 1987. In additional to wildlife, the Reserve also protects a substantial part of the Sapta Koshi, (a tributary of the Ganges River) flood plain. In 1987, it was declared a Ramsar site. The reserve is also home to the water buffalo (called arna), deer, nilgai, mugger crocodile, Ganges River Dolphin (also called the Gangetic Dolphin), and over 280 species of birds.

- Birding in the near by surroundings of the park
- Sunset walk and view from the river bank
- Dinner and slide show about flora-fauna

Day 02: Activities

- Wake up call, refresh drinking tea or coffee
- Morning nature walks within near surrounding area
- Breakfast
- Boating on the Sapta Koshi River with a naturalist to observe water birds, water buffaloes, dolphins and various water habitats
- Disembark by the bank of the river and have picnic lunch
- Short drive to the Koshi Barrage to view some bird-life and fresh water Dolphins
- Late afternoon return to the camp
- Dinner

Day 03: Activities

- Wake up call, refresh drinking tea or coffee
- More bird watching around
- Have breakfast and pack
- Transfer to Biratnagar airport and fly to Kathmandu

Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve

Suklaphanta Wildlife Reserve lies in the extreme south west of the Terai and covers an area of 305 sq. km (including extension area) and ranges in altitude from 90-270 m. The vegetation cover within the reserve has been estimated as approximately two-third forest and one-third grassland. Of these, the Suklaphanta grassland is probably the largest patch of grassland of Nepal, occupying an area of 54 sq km. Twenty-six species of mammal have been recorded here, including a population of



1,710-2,250 swamp deer. The reserve also holds Nepal's largest breeding population of Bengal Floricans and Hispid Hare.

The great majority of the land, particularly in the hills, remains unvisited and therefore undisturbed. This is ideal for wildlife, and also preserves an element of mystery for humans; because large areas are still unexplored, our knowledge of what birds and animals the park contains is by no means final and there is always the possibility of naturalists making new discoveries.
